Airport Nuremberg fully open in May - No runway closure

Dear Sir or Madam,

due to the extraordinary situation and almost the complete lost of traffic in April, we are happy to announce that we will cancel the runway closure in May. We will provide full service 24/7 in Nuremberg as you are used to.

Together with the authorities and our contractors we will move the planned construction work to April without restrictions for the daily business. Therefore Nuremberg Airport is 24/7 open also in April.

Furthermore you might know, it was planned that widebody aircraft would have been not accepted during the whole period in May.

For now we need to shift the period from 20.04.2020 until 04.05.2020. In this period we can not accept aircraft ICAO code letter D (with a main undercarriage width greater than/equal to 9m) and all ICAO code letter E and F aircraft. This will be necessary as a safety margin to avoid suction of FOD from the construction side. Hence the widebody aircraft mentioned above are permitted to use the airport in May.

We will inform the flight plan coordinator of the Federal Republic of Germany for the period of widebody aircraft restrictions and also the open nights in May.

We kindly ask for your understanding in these hard times and stay healthy.
